#### **Reminders About Inclement Weather**


The safety and well-being of students and staff is our top priority and the decision to close, delay or release school is a difficult decision. Before deciding to modify the school day due to extreme weather conditions, the Superintendent consults with a variety of District, Local and County authorities. Our commitment is to keep students, families and staff safe, as well as keep the community informed of weather-related school closings, delays and cancellations.

The typical district procedure for delaying or cancelling school in the event of extreme cold weather includes the following:

- School Closing/Delay/Early Release Announcements will be made on local television (ABC, CBS, NBC) and radio (KMA 99.1 and KSIB 101.3) stations, as well as through Lamoni FaceBook, JMC Blast and on the District website @ www.lamonischools.org as soon as a decision can be made.
- For extreme cold weather situations, school will typically be <u>delayed</u> if the forecasted wind chill from the NWS at 7:00 am is at or below -25°F.
- Generally, school will be <u>cancelled</u> if the forecast for 10:00 am shows potential frostbite times in 10 minutes or less according to the "windchill chart" on the following page.
- These are guidelines, not absolutes, as the weather conditions for each day will be considered in order to make a decision.
- Unless otherwise noted, all activities, athletic events and practices are cancelled when school is cancelled or dismissed early.
- LEEP Preschool Students will follow the same school closing/delay/early release procedures as students in Kindergarten 12th grade. 3 year old AM students would not attend the morning session if the school experiences a 2 hour delay.
- Exploration Academy will not be held if school is cancelled, delayed or released early.
- The State of Iowa provides school districts the flexibility to provide up to five virtual days of instruction in a school year. If the District determines to designate a day as and provide virtual instruction, this will be formally communicated to students and families. Any work assigned to students will be required to be turned in when school resumes in person to count as a day of attendance for students.

Please note that we continually monitor the forecast from the National Weather Service (NWS) for Des Moines <a href="https://www.weather.gov/">https://www.weather.gov/</a> in order to make the best decision for students, staff and families in a timely manner. We also utilize the NWS's National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) wind chill chart and the





Iowa Department of Public Health's Child Care Weather Watch chart as reference documents and have included

#### Understand the Weather



#### Wind-Chill

- 30° is chilly and generally uncomfortable
- 15°to 30° is cold
- · 0° to 15° is very cold
- -20° to 0° is bitter cold with significant risk of frostbite
- -20° to -60° is extreme cold and frostbite is likely
- -60° is frigid and exposed skin will freeze in 1 minute
