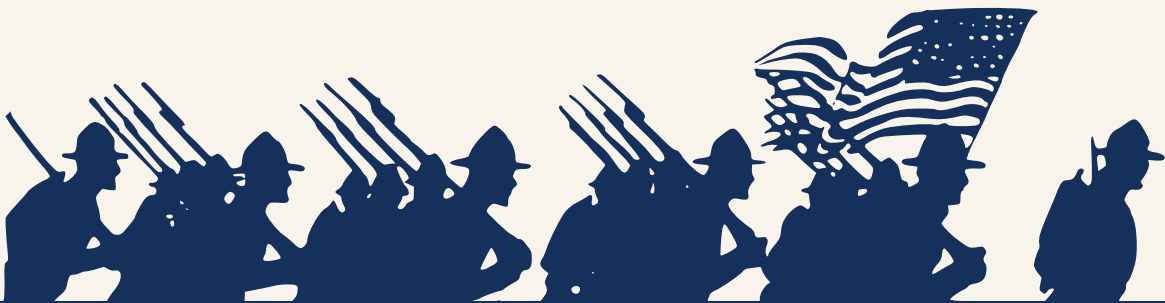

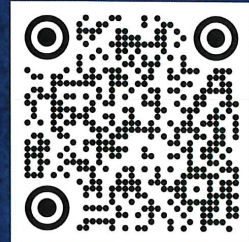

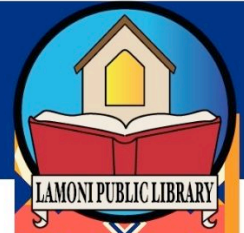

Amanda Cawthorn is registered with the Oneida Nation of Wisconsin. She enjoys sharing the Oneida culture through CultureAll because she wants to help audiences see past the many stereotypes about Native Americans and to understand that Native cultures are still alive and strong in the present. Participants will learn about what a powwow is and why they are important, while being invited to take in the vibrant colors, sounds, and tastes of an Oneida powwow.
