

Lamoni Return to Learn July 31, 2020

Lamoni will begin school on Wednesday, August 26 in the On-Site model. Families may choose to access Remote Learning for their child(ren) due to COVID-19 concerns, instead of attending on-site. All families will communicate in regards to their plans, as part of online registration, so each building may plan accordingly. This information is included as part of online registration. Details for the school models are included below, and are subject to change based on health and policy updates from the Department of Education, Governor Reynolds, and Public Health.

On-Site (Traditional)	Lamoni Remote Learning
<p>Face-to-Face instruction for all students in the building in a mostly traditional model.</p> <p>Monday - Friday 8:00 - 3:05</p> <p>Staff will be encouraged to wear face coverings. These will be provided by the district. Staff will meet workplace health protocols.</p> <p>Face coverings for students will be encouraged when social distancing is not feasible. Parents will be asked to provide face coverings for their children. Each student will need to have a face covering available (kept in their backpack or locker) to use each day, for times when social distancing is not possible.</p> <p>We will not be taking temperatures of individual students. Families will need to ensure students are healthy when they come to school. All children should be fever free (less than 100.4) for a minimum of 24 hours.</p> <p>Students with illness symptoms will be isolated, and must be picked up from school within 30 minutes of notification.</p> <p>Lamoni has a health and safety plan which includes, but is not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Frequent hand washing 	<p>A student does not attend school in person.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Attendance and participation is required. ● Grades and credits will be given during remote learning. ● Parents may select remote learning for individual children and families. Students shall remain in this model for 1 semester. ● Coursework may be self-paced and can be completed at varying times throughout the day and week. ● Laptops will be provided to every 3rd-12th grade student. Each K-2 family will be provided access to at least 1 laptop. ● Grab and Go lunches may be available. ● Special Education students will be provided appropriate support and materials, per the IEP. <p>If a parent selects remote learning, the district will provide instruction through one of the two models listed below. This will be at the discretion of the school, and will be finalized based on numbers from initial school registration.</p> <p><u>Lamoni Remote Learning</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will access recorded and/or live content from Lamoni teachers.

- Sanitizer stations will be available throughout the buildings and in classrooms.
- Water fountains will be used as bottle filling stations only. A water bottle will be provided by the district. These will be sent home daily for washing.
- Staff and students will help disinfect their learning spaces (desks, chairs, etc).
- Classes will use individual bathroom times, rather than whole class times.
- Elementary computers will be sanitized between uses.
- No large group assemblies will be held.
- There will be no field trips in the fall.
- Students will not be able to take backpacks to classrooms.
- Students will not be allowed to take computers to lunch.
- Cross traffic in the hallways will be minimized.
- Shared supplies (such as art) will be minimized or disinfected between uses.

Lunch: Lines will be minimized for lunch. Schedules will be adjusted to reduce the number of students eating at one time. Students will eat with their classroom groups. Meals will be served in areas that allow for adequate spacing and may be outside. Students will not be allowed to self-serve at meals. Disposable silverware may be provided.

Elementary Recess: Students will use hand sanitizer as they go out the door, and wash their hands on return to the building.

Transportation: Buses will operate at normal capacity (typically 20-30 kids) and face coverings are encouraged but not required.

Exploration Academy: EA starts on Aug 26th and will follow the same protocols.

- Grades will be given by Lamoni teachers.
- Teachers will be available for meetings with individual students at pre-arranged times.
- Curriculum materials will match the on-site learning model.

Online Remote Learning

- Students will access recorded and/or live content via an online vendor
- All support and grading is provided through the online vendor.
- Curriculum materials will be provided by the online vendor and may differ from the on-site learning model.
- Courses will cover core content and can be used to meet graduation credits.
- This option does not include elective courses offered by Lamoni.
